FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOHN SEPER

33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

St. Richard Parish Roofing Project:

A Letter – A Response – Permissions – Awaiting Project Start

I sent a letter to Archbishop Carlson on October 26th, “requesting permission to begin Phase One of a series of Roof Projects for St. Richard Church.” **Phase One** addresses our most pressing roofing needs:

1. New roof on O’Brien Hall / Gym, which has been leaking for better than ten years
2. New roof on the entrance to O’Brien Hall, the area connecting O’Brien Hall and the
3. Kitchen leading to our Parish Life Center (formerly known as the School)

Temporary repair of leaks in Church entrance, involving patches and flashing

Phase Two would be a new roof of the Parish Life Center.

Phase Three would be roof repair for the Church.

I received a response from the Archbishop through Rev. Msgr. Dennis Stehly, Vicar General/Moderator of the Curia, in a letter dated October 31, 2017. Along with his commendations for our planning process, he congratulated St. Richard Parish “on retiring the parish debt and raising funds for phase one.” He went on to write, “I have spoken with Mr. Bob Palisch and Mr. Randy Rathert of the Building and Real Estate Office (for the Archdiocese of St. Louis), and ask that you get in touch with either of these men so that they may advise and assist you. They bring a wealth of experience and expertise to roofing repair and would be happy to work with you and your parish in getting phase one completed. You have the permission to proceed with your plan.”

That’s great news! I have been in contact with Mr. Palisch and Mr. Rathert over the phone, and will meet with them shortly. We had secured several proposals for the work, with preliminary estimates. We will finalize the scope of project, specifications for work to be accomplished, and then go out to competitive bids. While this project will not be accomplished before year end, as I had hoped, we should be ready to begin work on Phase One in the spring.

All of this would not be possible if not for your extraordinary Stewardship, through:

- A Special Envelope for Roof Repair, in conjunction with a \$35,000 Challenge Matching Grant
- Memorial Gifts, directed toward our roofing projects
- Our new monthly Repair and Maintenance Envelope

Thank you for making great things happen here at St. Richard Parish!

Rosary Group AM:

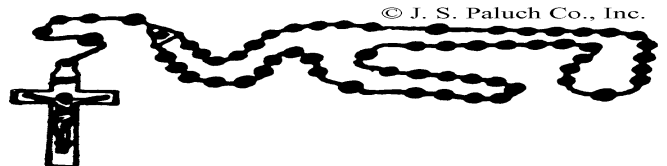

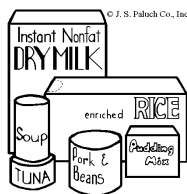
Khader & Mary Abu Sada, a Catholic couple from the **Holy Land**, will be visiting our parish to market olive wood hand carved religious articles made by the Christian artisans in the Holy Land. With the hostilities worsening in the Holy Land and due to the lack of Christian pilgrims, the outlets for the olive wood carvings have been closed, leading unemployment to increase up to 75%, forcing many Christians to leave the Holy Land in order to find other ways to market their handiwork. The absence of a living Christian community is very disastrous for the Holy sites, such as the **Church of Nativity** and the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**.

They are going to display all kinds of olive wood religious art works such as: Nativity scenes, Crucifixes, figures, rosaries, etc... which are unique and not usually found in religious stores. These crafts make wonderful presents for all occasions especially for Christmas. Their price range is from \$8.00 to \$700.00. Checks and credit card are welcome. Please take the opportunity on **Nov 25th & 26th** to check out these unique crafts and hopefully you would be able to assist our brothers and sisters in the Land of Jesus by purchasing some of these religious goods. Buying one piece will help prevent Christians from leaving the Holy Land.

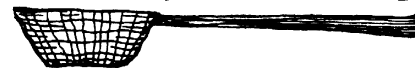
