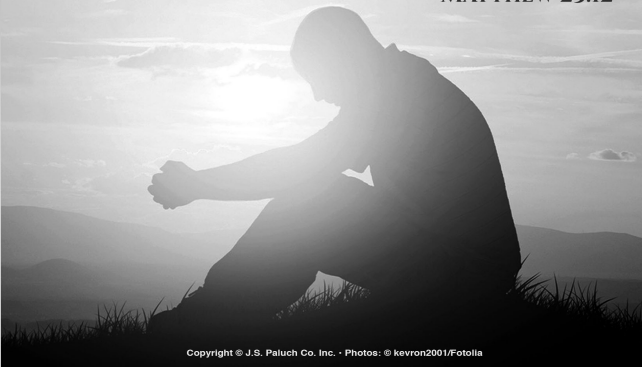

## FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOHN SEPER

November 04-05, 2017

### 31<sup>st</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

#### RCIA: Rite of Acceptance and Welcoming

It all began some time ago, long before our first meeting. But what we are finding out is just how much we have in common. You see, a group of people has been meeting at the Parish Life Center, just about every Thursday evening, since the beginning of August, to talk about their journey of faith. What we share are stories about our lives and experiences, the events and memories that have in some way shaped how we think, what we believe, and how we live. What makes this group so special is that we meet here at St. Richard Church, and most of us aren't even Catholic!

You see, these people come as *Inquirers*, to learn more about the Catholic Church. Their questions are a lot like the questions that any of us might ask: "What does the Catholic Church teach about...?" "How is it that some Christian Churches say...but the Catholic Church says...?" "Why do Catholics...?" Well, you know the questions, just fill in the blanks. They are good questions, questions about who we are, what we believe and teach, and why we do what we do. That's why we spend the first weeks in the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (the RCIA)** in a *Period of Inquiry*.

Now that this introductory phase had come to an end, we marked the transition of our *Inquirers* into the next stage of the RCIA by a celebrating a special ritual: **The Celebration of the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens and of the Rite of Welcoming Baptized but Previously Uncatechized Adults Who are Preparing for Confirmation and/or Eucharist or Reception into the Full Communion of the Catholic Church.** (Seriously, that really is the name of the ritual!) And now that we have celebrate this lovely ceremony, our *Inquirers* become known as *Catechumens* (those presently not Baptized), and *Candidates* (those already Baptized in a Christian tradition, intending to enter into full communion in the Catholic Church).

Each Catechumen or Candidate has a **Godparent or Sponsor**, who serves as a spiritual companion, and is someone with whom they can talk and share. Deacon John Bischof and I facilitate these Thursday meetings with our Catechumen and Candidates, and are accompanied by other parishioners who share in this journey of faith.

Please join me in welcoming all those who have celebrated this special rite of passage this past Sunday, October 29<sup>th</sup>, at our 11:00 a.m. Mass. **Catechumen:** Charles Akato; **Candidates:** Julia Disner, Deborah Fischer, and Shirley Plegge.

With our warm greetings, prayers and support may we encourage them in this journey of grace, knowing that their faith enriches our parish community. And may God keep us all growing great in His love.
